



Club Membership Application Process



Fill out the application form and email it to the Club Membership Chair (link on the website). No payment is due at this time.



You will be invited to an interview with a membership committee member and your sponsor, where Rotary and our club's requirements will be discussed. Your application will be submitted to the Rotary Club of New Braunfels Membership Committee, and then to the Board of Directors for review and approval. Afterwards, there will be two consecutive Wednesday "readings" before the membership approval process is complete. It is about a one-month process from the date of your application submittal to your official induction.



Following final approval, the prospective member will be invited to the next regular Wednesday meeting for official induction into the club.

Member Obligations and Expectations



You should expect your annual membership to cost approximately \$1,000-\$1,200. Beginning July 1, 2019, all new members will be billed for their meals through the end of the current quarter. All members are billed quarterly for dues and meals. Timely payment upon quarterly receipt of invoice for meals and dues = approximately \$250-300 per quarter and includes prepayment of meals.



Members are required to maintain an in-person attendance of no less than 50%. Make-ups for missed meetings can be accomplished by attending another Rotary Club's meeting (Downtown Rotary meets on Thursdays), by attending a monthly board meeting, attending a club social, or by completing an e-club meeting. No other make-ups will be accepted unless explicitly approved by the Rotary Club of New Braunfels Board of Directors. Make-ups are good for two-weeks before or after the make-up date.



All members are required to work at our major club community events, the Hill Country Craft Beer Festival in April, and our Wurstfest booth in November.



As a new member you will receive a RED name badge. You should work toward earning your WHITE name badge as soon as possible by attending a Board Meeting, a Fireside Chat, a New Member Social, by setting-up your Club Runner profile with your picture and info, and by participating in a community service project. Work with your sponsor or the Membership Chair to find out more details about these requirements.



Our club meets every Wednesday (except holidays or as otherwise noted) from 12:00 PM to 1:00 PM at Columbus Club Hall on Landa Street, across from the Wurstfest Grounds. Meetings start promptly at 12:05 PM, but members are encouraged to arrive as early as 11:30 AM to socialize and take care of club business.



The Rotary of Club of New Braunfels is classified as a community service club, but also has value for networking, business, and personal relationship-building. We do not actively promote our business during lunch meetings, nor do we offer "business category exclusivity" for our members.
